

MODEL SPG2 STYLUS PRESSURE GAUGE



SPG2 Stylus Pressure Gauge

It is vitally important that the stylus pressure should be correct when playing modern records. The Garrard Stylus Pressure Gauge has been designed to provide an inexpensive and simple method of measuring this pressure.

The Gauge has a range of 0--15 grammes and, as an optional extra, a slide off base is supplied.

This base houses a spirit level for checking the level of the turntable.

The Gauge is finished with a red and cream plastic case with chromium plated fittings.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Remove the slide off base. With the pickup arm in the playing position and one record on the turntable, place the gauge on the record with the stylus point resting in the balance arm pan. Depress control lever to maximum and then release gradually until pointer is in the centre of the window. The reading on the scale will then be the stylus pressure in contact with the record.
